

## Glen Education Code of Conduct for Behaviour with Children

All children have the right to be safe and to feel safe.

It is our shared responsibility to protect children and uphold the principles of the code.

Glen Education employees, volunteers and visitors are required, under the Code of Conduct for Behaviour with Children Policy, to behave at all times in a way that respects the rights of children and upholds the Glen Education vision, mission and values. This Code provides a framework for reflections about the ethical responsibilities of professionals as well as those who work for, volunteer with, or utilise the services of Glen Education.

## All those who enter a Glen Education Environment will:

- Promote a safe and secure environment for children by acting with a duty of care and diligence
- Regard all children equally, and with respect and dignity
- Speak to children in an encouraging and positive manner
- Inform children if physical contact is required for any purpose, and ask them if they are comfortable with this interaction
- Listen actively to children and offer empathy and support
- Give each child positive guidance and encourage appropriate behaviour
- Ensure all interactions with children are undertaken in full view of other adults
- Contribute to an environment that is free from discrimination, bullying and harassment
- Act as an advocate for children and respect the rights of the child as active members of the community
- Act with integrity and honesty at all times
- Honour the histories, cultures, languages, traditions and lifestyle choices of all children
- Actively promote a sense of belonging, connectedness and wellbeing for children in order to help them develop the confidence to have a voice
- Communicate respectfully with each other
- Respect privacy, maintaining appropriate confidentiality about information gained about each child while participating in the program.
- Model and strive for high quality practices and professionalism at all times
