WEEK 1: Child & Family Orientation

All Children (and parent/guardian) to attend our *Child & Family Orientation* sessions from 8:30am – 1:00pm.

Drop-in style sessions in which families are welcome to attend anytime during 8:30am– 1:00pm, stay for as little or as long as you like. Children to attend on their enrolled session days only and **should attend a minimum of one session**. Families will have time to ask questions and explain individual needs to our educators and children will have an opportunity to engage with educators through play, and to begin familiarising themselves with the kindergarten environment.

A Parent/Guardian must remain with their child for the duration these sessions, which allows our educational teams time to get to know families on an individual basis and cultivates a positive start to kindergarten for children.
